The Rotary Club Of Chatham recognizes one student at JMH each year that models volunteerism in both the community at large and school. The Rotary motto "Service Above Self" conveys the humanitarian spirit of the organization's more than 1.2 million members. Strong fellowship among Rotarians and meaningful community and international service projects characterize Rotary worldwide. While a focus on academic achievement is essential to any student's future success, it is also important to place a high value on volunteering to community organizations and internally to school related activities.

Eligibility: The Rotary Club Of Chatham will award ONE \$1,000 CDN scholarship to a current graduate of JMH who has demonstrated "service above self" throughout their high school years. Sons and daughters of Rotary Club members are not eligible to apply.

This application is based on a number of components including:

- **Academic Achievement** – maintaining a consistent academic record;
- **Community Involvement** – ability to demonstrate meaningful contributions to community activities;
- **School Involvement** – applicants must demonstrate their voluntary participation in school activities
- **Provide a short document outlining why you feel you deserve this volunteer award.**

This award will be presented by the current President of the Rotary Club of Chatham or designate at this year's JMH graduation. The student in question will be invited to a Rotary Club to be recognized.

The deadline for submission of this application is **MAY 15th, 2020**. This application must be submitted to the Principal's Office of JMH on or before this date. No late applications will be accepted.

A committee of Rotary Club of Chatham members will review **ALL** applications and award one winner. The award is based on the information provided in this application. Additional information may be requested from the school in making the final decision.
